Our Story:

We are mobilized by the 1treellion movement to cool the planet. We are establishing a global community; a neighborhood based on trees. To cool the world, we plan to plant billions of trees. We've had enough waiting around for someone else to fix the harm done to our planet. Our responsibility is to effect change.

Simply planting a tree is insufficient. We must work together to raise money and awareness in order to change our current course. There is a charm in trees, music, and community (trillions of them). We expand in unforeseen ways when our branches are intertwined. You are at the right place, so you don't need to feel alone in your quest for change.



Our Mission:

The natural climatic remedy is trees. We are adamant that it can be done, but we must move swiftly and right away.

Our goal is to mobilize communities to plant 1 trillion (1,000,000,000,000) trees to cool the Earth by working together to have a significant global impact.

There are numerous programs and organizations that promote tree planting. Our own existence depends on it, and so far, very few of them have been successful. To help such groups, we want to do what we do best: create a movement and gather talent and funds 1treellion.org Global Fund.

WHO WE ARE

1treellion Global Funds (aka 1treellion) is a non-profit 501(c) (3) project committed to funding tree planting with communities. We are a 100% volunteer-based organization. We are a member of Catalyst 2030, a global movement of social entrepreneurs and social innovators with a common goal to promote the Sustainable Development Goals by 2030.

Our mission is to collectively raise enough funding to make a meaningful global impact and bring communities together to mitigate climate change by planting 1 trillion trees.

90% of the funds raised go directly to tree plantings, and 10% go to logistics and planting coordination. All of our current projects started as small, pilot projects to confirm local community commitment and success tree survival rates. Our goal is to expand tree planting at our current project sites and to plant 10 million trees by 2025.


1TREELLION AND OUR PROJECTS

We find that planting trees is the most natural and efficient way to lower carbon emissions and restore ecological and social balance in communities.

The ecological benefits of trees (including carbon sequestering, soil quality and groundwater quality improvement, an increase in biodiversity, and limited flooding and droughts) are only a small part of the wonders trees do. 1treellion distinguishes itself from other organizations in how it uses trees as a means for social advancement. The projects have directly linked trees to generating income, food security, sustainable cropping, and gender empowerment. Through building and maintaining tree nurseries, women are offered job security; farmers are taught sustainable agroforestry farming and food retrieval practices & trees become a tool for the education of the local youth. Through the promotion of diversity and inclusion in the projects, the overall quality of life of the community improves. In turn, this gives communities invested interest in the long-term survival of trees. In seeking a fair, equal, and even climate transition, trees become global equalizers!

1treellion has 12 successful small-scale tree planting projects in 9 countries:




Countries: Nicaragua, Brazil, Guatemala, Tanzania, Congo, Armenia, Kenya, Thailand, Uganda.

SUPPORTING THE SDG AGENDA

To support SDG 13 (Climate Action) and SDG 15 (Life on Land), we have planted 10,000 trees with an average survival rate of 80% (vs 19% global avg). And to support SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals), we have developed partnerships with nine tree-planting initiatives around the world.



Through funding the tree-planting initiatives of this project, 6,141 people have directly benefited, and another 222,015 have indirectly benefited by supporting SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) and SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities).



SUPPORTING THE SDG AGENDA

The funding of the tree-planting initiatives has helped create jobs, especially for **women**: Supporting SDG 10 (Reduces Inequalities), SDG 5 (Gender Equality), SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), and SDG 1 (No Poverty).

Numerous educational projects have been undertaken by our partners, including those for children, schools, and adults as well. The Kenyan initiative where kids own the trees in their schools serves as the best illustration of this. This encourages people to take good care of trees, is the best approach to producing a generation that will be environmentally friendly. This supports SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 15 (Life on Land), and SDG 4 (Quality Education).



1Treellion has funded a variety of tree nutrient-rich planting projects related that can be used for food in the communities in order to support SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 15 (Life on Land), SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being), SDG 2 (Zero Hunger), SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), and SDG 1 (No Poverty).

In Kenya, moringa trees are being planted as part of a project to give the community, especially the kids, a fresh source of nutrition. As soon as they start selling the powder, it will also help households have new income stream.

To help the neighborhood, our project in Guatemala planted an additional 3,800 legumes and 950 fruit trees.
